Logistics & SCM in India

India has a population of 1.3 billion and an area of 3.288 million km². As a nation, India has a diverse range of resources, industries and capabilities. In terms of logistics infrastructure, India: has 12 major (and 60 non-major) operational ports with 800 million metric tonnes of cargo capacity; is the 4th largest rail freight carrier in the world; has 4.86 million km of roads and highways; and, aviation carried 163m passengers in 2013 with India set to be the 3rd largest aviation market by 2020.
